



ROAD CLOSURE

On Saturday 1st December 2012, Mill Road will be closed to traffic between East Road and Coleridge Road between 10:30am and 4:30pm

Your property/business is in the area affected by the road closure.

Anyone requiring access to your business/property between 10.30am and 4.30pm which requires transit through Mill Road should approach a Mill Road Winter Fair steward or member of TMS (the traffic management company that is running the closure on the day) and ask for advice. If you are not able to find a steward please call us on **07982 810343**. Please be patient, wait for instructions and proceed with care.

We strongly recommend that you keep vehicle movements to an absolute minimum within these hours, as the road will be full of people and they will not be expecting vehicles. We would be grateful if you could let us know of any planned movements by emailing us in advance of the day at safety@millroadwinterfair.org

The roads adjoining Mill Road are open as normal. However, if you are a resident of Romsey Terrace, Great Eastern Street, the Mill Road end of Argyle Street, Campbell Street, Stockwell Street, Sedgwick or Thoday Street (between St Phillips Road and Mill Road), Perowne Street, Emery Street, Emery Road, Mackenzie Road, Collier Road, Willis Road, Guest Road or Mortimer Road, you will also be affected by the closed zone of Mill Road. The gates at the top of Gwydir Street will be open during the day allowing passage into and out of Gwydir Street.

The Citi2 bus service will not run down Mill Road during the closure period. It will be diverted around East Road, Newmarket Road, Coldhams Lane and Brooks Road. If you are cycling, please dismount and push your bike through the road closure.

This road closure has been granted by Cambridgeshire County Council to ensure the safety of pedestrians attending the Mill Road Winter Fair. You can find a map and further details in our brochure or online at www.millroadwinterfair.org
